

General Rules MLSR Lake McClure Hang Gliding Site

1. You are responsible for your own quests. Be sure they pay all required fees, USHGA members, Hang III, signed waiver. Guests may fly twice, after that must join the club or pay day use fee of \$10.00.
2. You must wear a helmet.
3. You must carry a parachute.
4. Ridge Rules: Clear your turns; the pilot nearest the hill has the right of way. Pilots thermaling together should all turn the same way.
5. Tandem Ratings: You are responsible for the rules of the rating you hold.
6. Haul out your own trash.
7. **Obey ALL Rules**
8. USHGA Hang 2 pilots must be sponsored by an observer or an instructor. An instructor must inform the club president or VP of a students release from instruction as soon as possible. The sponsor must be present at launch with the Hang 2 pilot when they launch.

USHGA CHAPTER RESPONSIBILITIES FOR INSURED SITE MANAGEMENT

1. All pilots using the site must be current full members of USHGA.
2. The chapter will monitor the site to assure that only USHGA members fly and that the waiver form includes the name of USHGA
3. The chapter will establish minimum pilot rating requirements.
4. Pilots will be required to wear a helmet.
5. The chapter will give a list of additional insured and their interest the named property.
6. Should a claim be filed against a landowner the chapter will be responsible for a portion of the deductible.
7. Any occurrence caused by a non-member of USHGA could result in the local Chapter being held responsible.

MID COOPERATIVE HANG GLIDING AGREEMENT

1. Hang gliders my land only in the area adjacent to the south side of old hwy 132, north of the entrance road to Horseshoe Bend Recreation Area.
2. Flying over the campgrounds is strictly prohibited.
3. MLSR shall provide to MID site insurance satisfactory to MID.
4. MLSR shall immediately report all hang gliding accidents to MID.
6. MID shall provide MLSR with keys to the gates, MLSR shall provide MID a list of key holders. No keys shall be duplicated.
7. MLSR shall insure that Mariposa County Ordinance Title 12 Chapter 12.16 is fully complied with.
8. All pilots shall have a signed release.
9. Pilots are in good standing with USHGA.
10. Pilots have paid fees.
11. No vehicles allowed in LZ after dark.
12. No spectators not associated with hang gliding are allowed in the landing zone.
13. No pilots can be under the age of eighteen years of age.
14. No passengers or students allowed who are not subject to all provisions of the agreement.
15. Before a pilot may use the LZ they shall be provided with a copy of the LMHGR and shall read and sign that they are understood.

KEY HOLDER AGREEMENT

1. Key holder is responsible to enforce all the rules of the MLSR.
2. Key holder is responsible for whomever they allow through the gates or escort to launch of any MLSR insured site to include collecting fees, be sure park fees are paid and that the MID rules and regulations are followed, signing of waivers.
3. Key holder may only give their key to their driver or another key holder. Drivers are not allowed to let anyone in through any gates but may let drivers/pilots out of gates or into the LZ.
4. Key holder is responsible for getting day use fees to the treasurer and waivers and receipts.
5. All key holders must stop at the LZ or designated waiting area to assist any non-key holder to launch.

MID PARKS DEPARTMENT REGULATIONS

MARIPOSA COUNTY ORDINANCE TITLE 12, CHAPTER 12.16

1. Day Use Permit Fee Required (Vehicle/Pet/Boat)
2. No towing any airborne kite, parachute or hang glider.
3. No hang gliding activities are permitted after daylight hours
4. No vehicles in LZ after dark.
5. All group activities require an assembly permit 30 days prior to the event.
6. No person shall operate any vehicle at a speed in excess of the posted limit.
7. No vehicle shall be left unattended other than those designated for parking.
8. No person shall operate any motor vehicle without a muffler system conforming to the provisions of the CVC.
9. No person shall operate a motorcycle except between the hours of 7:00am and 11:00pm on established roads only.
10. No person shall operate skateboards, skated, or similar device of this type.
11. No person shall camp or picnic except in designated sites and then only with a permit.
12. No person shall occupy a campsite overnight with more than eight occupants without approval.
13. No person shall occupy a campsite for more than 14 days without special permission.
14. Quiet time will be enforced from 11:00pm to 7:00am.
15. No person shall pick flowers, foliage, berries or fruit, or cut, break, dig up or in any way mutilate or injure any tree, shrub, plant, fern, grass, turf, fence, structure or any other object without permission from the district.
16. No person shall cut, carve, paint, mark, paste or fasten to any tree, fence, wall, building, monument or other object any bill, ad or inscription when such action would destroy or deface property without permission from the district.
17. No person shall dig up or remove any dirt, stones, rocks or other substances whatever, make any excavation, quarry any stone, or lay or set off any blast or cause or assist in doing any for said things without permission from the district.
18. No person shall molest, injure or kill any bird or mammal or disturb its habitat without permission from the district.
19. No person shall despoil, place or leave any broken glass, ashes, wastepaper, cans or other rubbish or polluted matter except in a receptacle provided for that purpose.

20. No person shall possess, discharge or set off, over, onto, or through the recreation area any firearms, firecrackers, torpedoes, rockets, or other explosives or fireworks.
21. No person shall permit or allow any domestic animal to be within the LMRA unless same are at all times under the actual and physical control of the owner or person having custody; animals are not allowed on beaches or in swimming areas. All dogs must be on a leash no longer than 101 in length.
22. No person shall engage in soliciting, selling or peddling any goods or services or distribute any circulars which would endanger or violate the public health, safety, morals or general welfare.
23. No swimming will be allowed at swimming lagoons between dusk and sunrise.
24. Open fires are prohibited unless authorized by park manager.
25. All Mariposa County Parks shall be closed to the public during the months of October through March at 10:00pm until 8:00am and during the months of April through Sept. from 11:00pm until 7:00am.

Except as otherwise provided, any person who violates any of the provisions of this chapter is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punishable by a fine of not more than \$500.00 or by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than 6 months or by both such fine and imprisonment. The above regulations apply to Hang gliding, vehicle, day use and camping regulations. Please refer to county regulations for water use.

Launch Landowner RULES

1. No Smoking
2. No Camping
3. Leave the gates as you find them.
4. Stay on the road.
